Girl Scouts of Eastern Pennsylvania Heritage Patrol is one of many Interest Patrols available to Cadette, Senior and Ambassador Girl Scouts. Interest Patrols are a fun addition or alternative to the traditional troop meeting format.

Heritage Patrol is a special interest group dedicated to learning about our local heritage, sharing this knowledge with others, and providing service to local organizations working to preserve our heritage. We do special events for Brownies, Juniors, and Cadettes, history related field trips, and a week long program at Musikfest. If you are interested in early American folk arts, exploring local history, participating in community events and sharing your skills with younger girls, you will enjoy being a member of Heritage Patrol.

Kicking off **November 13** at Burnside Plantation, the Apprentice Patrol will address the changes in Girl Scout age levels. Sixth grade Cadettes and older girls who did not start their Heritage Patrol experience with Musikfest will be able to join the Apprentice Patrol. This Heritage Patrol group will meet during Burnside Plantation Day, Victorian Pastimes, Thinking Day—Heritage Style and Moravian Memories from 1 to 4 in the afternoon. Girls attending all sessions will earn their Artistic Crafts IPP. They also will learn the leadership skills needed to advance to Journeywomen during these sessions. A \$15.00 fee will be charged for this program. All girls must be registered Girl Scouts. They may be registered
